STEP-BY-STEP NAVIGATING THE TFWP

Submit a Labour Market Impact Assessment (LMIA)* application to Service Canada including employment agreement (up to 6 months prior to start date)

> Pay the \$1,000 processing fee (except for permanent residence dual intent LMIAs)

Obtain a positive LMIA*

> Provide a copy of the LMIA* to your worker

Advise your worker to apply for a work permit

Annually ensure your workers' wages reflect increases to prevailing wage rates


