CALL FOR NOMINATIONS

TOURISM HR CANADA BOARD OF DIRECTORS

Tourism HR Canada has three open seats to replace Directors that have completed their full term. Election of the new Directors will take place at the next Annual General Meeting of the organization, on January 30, 2023.

The Nominations Committee, led by Joe Baker, Board Director, is seeking nominations to fill three seats, one for each of:

1. Provincial or regional tourism sector or related association.
2. Tourism educator, researcher, or educational institution.
3. Provincial, regional, pan-Canadian, or international business or related organization with an emphasis on tourism or tourism-related services (i.e., at large).
